## EQUALITY

**It is widely accepted that education has a major impact on poverty. Children from marginalized communities are denied the opportunity to lift themselves out of poverty through lack of investment in schools and teachers. We advocate for and make such investment. However access to education is not enough, the Education provided must foster equality of opportunity. We believe children from marginalized communities attending public sector schools should have EQUAL school infrastructure, EQUAL teacher capacity and EQUAL classroom facilities as any child attending a fee paying school in the private sector. We proactively advocate for and invest in Equality of education.**



## OUR APPROACH

OUR APPROACH SUPPORTS MARGINALIZED COMMUNITIES, ADDRESSES INEQUALITY AND EXCLUSION, ENCOURAGES PUBLIC PARTNERSHIP AND LOCAL OWNERSHIP AND PROVIDES A SUSTAINABLE SOLUTION.

### RURAL

Communities located outside urban centers are often neglected due to the geographical challenges. It is often deemed more cost effective to support schools in cities, close to roads and international transport links. This excludes the most marginalized from opportunity. [We support isolated marginalized communities.](#)

### PUBLIC

Government run schools are often deemed too difficult to manage. Teachers employed in the public sector are often deemed lazy or unskilled with little incentive to change. This wrongful perception encourages the funding of costly unsustainable private schools. [We support public sector schools.](#)

### PARTNERSHIP

Any solution should be sustainable. We partner with local community and local government to utilize existing resources. All teachers salaries are paid by the government and the community provides additional support. Equality can be sustainable. [We partner for sustainability.](#)



### COMMUNITY

All too often social investors lack a strategy for effective lasting impact, delegating the use of funds to local agents and disbursing resources widely across multiple programs and locations. We focus on a One Community holistic approach. We encourage the participation and co-operation of all schools in a community to a long term plan. This approach enables sharing of limited resources and the development of and adherence to a common strategy for quality of teaching and measurable impact. [We plan for lasting impact.](#)



## OUR PROGRAMS

OUR PROGRAMS PROVIDE SOLID FOUNDATIONS, PROTECT VULNERABLE CHILDREN, ENCOURAGE AND INSPIRE TEACHERS AND ENABLE YOUNG ADULTS TO BE STRONG AND COMPETITIVE.



## INFRASTRUCTURE

We believe that investment in a safe secure inspiring learning environment is vital for lasting impact. Trained teachers will not be motivated in dangerous schools and children will not be inspired by dark dismal spaces. However, as highlighted by the recent Earthquake such investment should be managed responsibly. Often limited aid is not directed to-awards costly infrastructure, but when funds are allocated, they are wholly inadequate. Far too often schools are built poorly placing children at unacceptable risk. We have always put children first.

## CREATIVE EARLY YEARS

Our Kindergartens are designed to foster and support creative learning and child centered teaching at the very beginning of school life. They include brightly painted walls, child friendly furniture, special dual language books and creative educational toys. Our school meals encourage parents to bring children to school at early age and unburden the older siblings from child minding duties. **We foster creative first steps.**



## CHILD CENTERED LEARNING

Teacher capacity in Nepal is poor with little focus on the development of creative thinking. We provide continuous development programs that motivate and inspire teachers and supply materials, books and educational aids. **We invest in Child centered Learning capacity.**

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE

Every parent wants the best for their child. Some are able to afford to send their children to fee paying English medium schools. However many are left behind in schools with no or inadequate English Language teaching. They are at an immediate disadvantage and are unable to compete for limited opportunities. We recognize the challenges faced by rural public sector teachers and we do not advocate English Medium teaching across all subjects, however Equality in the marketplace requires equality in language skills. **We promote English Language as a tool towards equality.**

# MAKE A CHILD STRONG!

## **HOW YOU CAN HELP MAKE CHILDREN STRONG THROUGH EDUCATION!**

As we confirmed recently, all the schools we built with your support are, every day providing strong safe and secure learning environments for over 600 children in Tandrang. However the community parents and children still face real challenges every day. Many children in Tandrang have no school buildings, many are not attending classes and are now at real risk. Please help us reach these children before it is too late!



## FEED A HUNGRY MIND

Many young children attend school on empty stomachs, are unable to concentrate and struggle to enjoy learning. A donation of **£100** provides a 5 year old with a nourishing hot meal every morning and afternoon snack for one year.



## NURTURE FIRST STEPS

Early years education is not funded by the government, lacking teachers, community members work for free and without books or materials. A donation of **£500** provides a qualified kindergarten teacher to nurture the first steps of 50 children for a year.



## TRAIN A TEACHER

Teachers in the community we support are very committed to providing quality education but lack the skills and support. A donation of **£1000** provides a teacher salary plus the training with the creative learning skills they need to inspire and motivate 100 children.



## SUPPORT CHILDREN ATTEND SCHOOL

Many children in the community we support never get the chance to attend school, or they are forced to drop out early. A donation of **£2,000** provides students the uniforms and materials they need to attend primary school for a year.



## BUILD INSPIRING SPACES

Our Kindergartens are safe inspiring space with brightly painted walls, child friendly furniture, special dual language books and educational toys. A donation of **£3,000** provides bright and creative spaces to attract children to school.



## BUILD STRONG SCHOOLS

Many of the children in Tandrang have no school buildings and attend lessons in a tin shed, out in the open or no longer attend at all. A donation of **£8,000** provides 50 children with a safe secure learning environment including furniture and learning materials.
